Dear Senior,

Cape Hatteras Electric Cooperative would like to congratulate you on your upcoming graduation. Our cooperative has a strong commitment to the local community. As a result, we are offering three scholarships to seniors graduating in 2022 who excel in the classroom and in the community. Academic success, extra-curricular activities and financial need will be measured during the application review process.

Each scholarship is worth \$1,000 per semester, for up to eight semesters (\$8,000 in total). The scholarships are available to qualified students attending an accredited technical/vocational school, community college, or four-year college or university. Scholarships will be paid in \$1,000 increments at the beginning of each semester for which the recipient is a full-time registered student.

Scholarship recipients must achieve a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher (on a 4.0 scale GPA) at the end of the second semester, and each semester thereafter, to continue receiving financial aid from CHEC.

Selected applicants will appear before the CHEC Scholarship Committee for a personal interview. Each interview will take approximately 5 minutes. Qualifying applicants will be notified of the time of their interview, which will be scheduled during the end of April.

Applications must be submitted to the guidance office at Cape Hatteras Secondary School or CHEC's Buxton office by 5:00pm on Tuesday, March 15, 2022. Digital copies can be emailed to laurae@chec.coop.
